

2026-2 Semester Dormitory Move-in Notice

The move-in schedule for the 2026 Second Semester Dormitory (including students continuing from the summer session) is announced as follows. Please read the information carefully and make sure to pay the dormitory fee within the designated payment period.

a. The payment invoice is issued based on the mandatory one-meal plan. Students who wish to have two meals per day must apply separately at the cafeteria after the semester begins

b. Refunds are available only if approved upon submission of supporting documents for hospitalization, field training, military training, etc

c. Dormitory Cafeteria Hours: Lunch: 11:30–13:30, Dinner: 17:30–19:00 (※No breakfast. Closed on weekends and public holidays)

7. Required Document: Tuberculosis (TB) Test Result

a. Only TB test results issued in or after August 2026 are valid. (All students must submit a new TB test result again, regardless of whether they submitted one for the Spring semester)

→ Students who fail to submit the TB test result will receive penalty points. Accumulated penalty points may result in mandatory eviction from the dormitory.

b. Take the TB test at a hospital or public health center near your residence and submit the test result

c. Chosun University Health Center TB Test Schedule: To be announced later on the university website. If you take the test at the university health center, the results will be sent directly to the dormitory office, so no separate submission is required

d. Students diagnosed with a contagious tuberculosis infection may have their dormitory admission canceled.

8. Move-in Procedure

a. Visit the Dormitory Administration Office (1st Floor) → Receive your room key and mattress cover → Move into your assigned room.

b. **Mattress Size:** You may use either the mattress cover provided by the dormitory or **your own mattress cover**

1) Glocal Baekhak Haksa: 200 cm × 100 cm × 25 cm (Due to furniture replacement, the dimensions differ from those in the 2025 academic year)

2) Global House: 198cm × 98cm × 21cm

9. Required Items & Prohibited Items

a. Items to Bring: Student ID (or other ID), mattress pad (quilted type only; single-layer pads are not allowed), blanket, pillow, toiletries, and other personal necessities.

b. Prohibited Items: Electric scooters, TVs, gas burners, portable heaters, irons, electric kettles, ramen cookers, toasters, electric blankets, electric heating pads, rice cookers, flammable materials, hazardous materials, and other heating appliances are prohibited. Bringing these items into the dormitory may result in mandatory eviction or penalty points. The prohibited items will be confiscated and disposed of

※ Students are fully responsible for any fire caused by prohibited items

- c. Permitted Electrical Appliances: Computers and peripherals, desk lamps, small refrigerators (50 liters or less), fans, chargers, mini vacuum cleaners, hair dryers, and small audio devices.
- d. Parcels: Packages that arrive before your move-in date may be lost. Please arrange for your package to arrive on or after your move-in date (The Dormitory Management Office is not responsible for lost packages)

10. Room Selection

a. How to Select Your Room: Comprehensive Information System → Dormitory → Room Selection → Select your preferred room

b. Application Period: August 20, 2026 (Thu) 13:00 – August 23, 2026 (Sun) 17:00

Students must complete the room selection themselves during this period

1) The room selection period may be changed depending on the administrative schedule

2) Single rooms will be assigned by lottery after eligible students submit their applications in mid-August

12. AI Roommate Matching

a. **Eligibility:** Available only to students moving into the dormitory for the **2026 second semester** who wish to participate

b. Application Period: August 14 (Fri) – August 17 (Mon), 2026

1) Students who apply for AI Roommate Matching cannot participate in the room selection period. They will be assigned to a designated floor and their room will be assigned randomly

2) Detailed information on the schedule and application procedure will be announced in August
